**Approval of May 30, 2005 meeting minutes. Motioned by Nicole Rioux, Seconded by Donna Sereda**

**New Business**

1. Team Rep Duties: As every team present has at least one player present who has been team rep previously, there was no need to go over the duties. Dawn directed anyone who is unsure of their duties to the website for a detailed description.
2. Important Dates: Both the Ice Breaker and the Sue B tourney will be held at View Royal (although a few of the Saturday games will be held somewhere else, most likely Vic West as it was last year).
3. Fields: Maria is waiting to hear back about our fields. As we've requested the same fields as last year, there shouldn't be any problems.
4. Intent to Enter:
  - Must be given at the next team rep meeting, which will be held on March 15 (email intent to Dawn).

5. Balls: Case of balls /team. Brenda will be distributing at the Ice Breaker tournament.
  6. Banned Bats Penalty:
    - Softball BC refers to Softball Canada who ejects both the bat and the player from the game if caught with a banned bat.
    - Banned Bat list will be posted on the website
    - It's too late to amend the Constitution, so we'll go with the Softball Canada rule this season (eject both bat and player from game). We'll revisit the topic next season.
    - It will be the Team Reps' responsibility to talk to their team and ensure that everyone knows and understands the rule and its consequences.
    - Let Dawn, or someone else from the Executive, if someone gets ejected from a game because of this rule.
  7. Fees: \$600... half due at the Ice Breaker tournament, which must be handed in to Brenda.
  8. Getting to Know You Tournament: One day tournament that we usually have in August. Tamara is going to talk to the President of SVI Minor ball to try and coordinate dates for the tourney.

  10. Registration and Insurance: Darcy will give out the forms at the next Team Rep meeting (March 15). The registration fees and forms will be due at the end of May
